

This chart explains the documentation required to verify dependent family member eligibility.

<b>Dependent Family Member</b>	<b>Required Documentation</b>
Spouse	Please submit a copy of your marriage certificate.
Registered Domestic Partner	Please submit a copy of the Declaration of Domestic Partnership filed with the Secretary of State showing Registered Domestic Partnership.
Natural, stepchild, adopted child	Please submit a copy of your child's birth certificate.
Foster child	Must show legal custody.
Legal ward	Must show legal custody and be claimed as your tax dependent by you or your spouse. Please submit a copy of your most recent tax federal tax return and the legal document granting custody.
Domestic partner's child	Must be claimed as a tax dependent by you or your registered domestic partner. Please submit a copy of your most recent tax federal tax return.
Disabled child age 26 or above, receiving Social Security Income or Supplemental Security Income	Please submit a copy of the award letter or a recent check stub.
Disabled child age 26 or above working in supported employment which can offset Social Security Income or Supplemental Security Income benefits	Please submit a copy of the award letter and a letter from the program in which your child is enrolled.
Disabled child age 26 or above	Must be claims as your tax dependent. Please submit a copy of your most recent tax federal tax return.
